

Speak of the Devil ~ District 73 Annual Convention 2018 Workshop Guidelines and Application Process

The theme for the 2018 District 73 Annual Convention is – **Speak of the Devil.** The Annual Convention will be held on Friday 18th May – Sunday 20th May 2018 at the Hotel Grand Chancellor, Hobart.

Ideally the workshop will fit into the DEVIL theme – Dream, Empower, Vocalise, Inspire, Lead. One or more of these themes can be incorporated into the workshop. Part of the event will be marketed outside of Toastmasters, so it is important to have content that would appeal to the general public as well as to existing Toastmasters.

Core Requirements

- ✓ 45 minutes in duration
- ✓ 30-100 participants
- ✓ Interactive
- ✓ Deliver solid outcomes (i.e. a new skill, a different perspective, a process for achieving success)
- ✓ The workshop relates to the event theme
- ✓ The workshop is complete it is not a taster of another event
- ✓ No selling is permitted from the stage
- ✓ You are available to audition your workshop for one or more members of the Annual Convention team during January/February (this will be in each state, so you do not need to fly to Melbourne)

Please be aware that you will still need to purchase a ticket for the Annual Convention, it is recommended you buy this during the early bird pricing period. All costs of the day are borne by the individual, not by District 73 or the Organising Committee.
